A CHARACTER INTRODUCED

It can be difficult to describe a character when they are introduced in a story. In this exercise everyone finds subtle ways to reveal 3 key details about a character in just a couple of paragraphs. The information should be described as part of an incident or story action, rather than stated as fact.

Here are the details you need to reveal:

- The approximate age of the character.
- Some detail of the character's appearance.
- What the character might want from life, a goal or motivation.

If anyone volunteers to read their piece, the other writers can be asked to guess the characters age, appearance, and goals.
